

TWAS ROLAC- ICSU ROLAC Joint Efforts



1st Meeting of Young Scientists TWAS-ICSU Latin American Young Scientists Conference.

- This meeting was held at the 14th TWAS-ROLAC Young Scientists Conference, from 5 to 6 December 2013, in Cancún, Mexico and the event was organized by TWAS and ICSU ROLAC and young scientists under the age of 40 participated in 20 countries of Latin America. The objectives of the meeting were:
 - 1) Increase the number of Latin American countries participating in the activities of ICSU and TWAS ROLAC.
 - 2) Strengthen existing regional links between TWAS and ICSU.
 - 3) To strengthen the links between the different disciplines in order to bring about a change of perceptions and visions.
 - 4) Expand the presence of ICSU ROLAC among the scientific youth, always with a gender perspective.
 - 5) Promote "Future Earth" in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Outcomes

- For the first time a meeting of young scientists with TWAS participation in the Region was achieved, with a high number of participating countries.
- Participating countries were present for the first time, small countries that are not represented in TWAS and are not members of ICSU.
- The development of this meeting made it possible to strengthen the existing regional links between TWAS and ICSU, creating a very positive atmosphere of collaboration between the two organizations for joint activities in the future.
- This event allowed the promotion of "Future Earth" in a select group of young scientists from Latin America and the Caribbean.
- The event facilitated the expansion of the presence of ICSU ROLAC among the scientific youth of different countries and establish a gender perspective in these activities.

Young Scientists Conference November 7-8, 2016

The Young Scientists Conference organized by TWAS ROLAC, ICSU ROLAC and the Vice Ministry of Science and Technology of El Salvador was held in San Salvador, El Salvador on November 7-8, 2016. There were established five objectives for this meeting. 1) To increase the number of Latin American countries which participate in TWAS and ICSU ROLAC activities. 2) To strengthen the current regional links between TWAS and ICSU. 3) To create bridges among the different disciplines in order to provoke an exchange of perceptions and visions. 4) To extend ICSU ROLAC presence among young scientists, with a gender perspective. 5) To promote the project “Future Earth” in the context of Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) region.

The participants consisted in three of the TWAS ROLAC Executive Committee members: Dr. Prof. Harold Ramkissoon -The University of the West Indies-, and Dr. Prof. Rafael Vicuña -Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile-, Dr. Prof. Manuel Limonta- ICSU ROLAC Regional Director, ICSU ROLAC Secretariat, and 19 Young Scientists under 40 years old nominated by the Presidents of 17 National Academies -Argentina, Barbados, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Panama, Peru and Uruguay. We also had the guest speakers, PhD. Prof. Rafel Vicuña from Chile and PhD. Prof. Harold Ramkissoon from Trinidad & Tobago.

We welcomed more than 700 participants in this two-day conference, amongst who can be mentioned different university representatives, independent researchers, government representatives, students and others. The audience enjoyed 18 presentations from the Young Scientists from the countries previously mentioned and also key lectures made by Prof. Vicuña and Prof. Ramkissoon.
