

HOW CAN WE INCREASE NUMBER OF YAS FROM UNDERREPRESANTED COUNTRIES

- Underrepresented countries should be determined
- Application or nomination
- Nominations coming from YAs should also welcome
- Organize activities in underdeveloped countries
- Increase visibility by social media, video etc and inform the benefits from TWAS membership
- YAs can act as ambassadors
- TWAS ROs can organize events out of their locations
- Within the current structure, we should position TYAN in regional offices
- Websites should be renewed and be user friendly
- ROs can be evaluated and if needed could be changed
- Increase membership engagement
- Newly elected YAs should contribute to TYAN and should have a role

WOMEN YOUNG AFFILIATES

- The criteria from LDCs and underrepresented countries can be more flexible. If similar CVs, prefer underrepresented / women
- Every baby is +2 years to 40 age limit
- Quote can be set for women/men YAs
- Sub-offices can be created
- Members should nominate at least one women for membership
- Connect rectors to nominate faculties
- Connect with NAs/NYAs to nominate

CONNECT TO ROS, PROPOSE IDEAS, TWAS FELLOW, MEMBERSHIP

- Rules and regulations for new members
- Write a letter on behalf of TYAN to TWAS fellows and ask for mentorship
- Clarity and uniformity

- Connect with other ROs
- Ask ROs to collaborate with NAs or similar bodies
